

Ordinance No. 936

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 19-121, Division 1, Article V, Chapter 19, of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, which Section 19-121 relates to TIME LIMITS OF PARKING METERS, which Division 1 relates to PARKING METERS ON STREETS, which Article V relates to PARKING METERS GENERALLY, and which Chapter 19 relates to MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 19-121, Division 1, Article V, Chapter 19 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

SEC. 19-121 TIME LIMITS OF METERS

The meters in the zones established in Sec. 19-120 shall be operated every day except on Sundays and legal State holidays, and said meters shall be operated between the hours of nine (9) o'clock A.M. and five (5) o'clock P.M., except as follows: King Street from Lee Street to Commonwealth Avenue, nine (9) o'clock A.M. to six (6) o'clock P.M., Mondays through Thursdays, nine (9) o'clock A.M. to nine (9) o'clock P.M. on Fridays; 100 block South Fairfax Street, nine (9) o'clock A.M. to six (6) o'clock P.M.

The time limits for parking in any space in said parking meter zones shall be determined by the deposit of a coin in each parking meter as follows:

Any period of time up to twenty minutes in those areas limited to twenty minute parking for five cents, one nickel.

Any period of time up to one hour in those areas limited to one hour parking for five cents, one nickel.

Any period of time up to one hour in those areas limited to two hours parking, five cents, one nickel for each hour.

All of the parking spaces operated in the meter zones established by Sec. 19-120 are hereby declared to be limited to one hour parking except as otherwise hereinafter declared:

The Parking spaces operated in the meter zones established by Sec. 19-120 are hereby declared to be limited to two hours parking on the following streets, except in those instances hereinafter limited to twenty minutes:

Prince Street between Royal Street and Columbus Street; Duke Street between St. Asaph Street and Columbus Street; Cameron Street between Pitt Street and Alfred Street; Washington Street

in the 200 and 300 blocks both north and south; and Fairfax Street in the 100 block south.

The parking spaces operated in the meter zones established by Sec. 19-120 are hereby declared to be limited to twenty minutes parking on the following portions of streets:

South Fairfax Street in the 100 block on the east side, 3 spaces immediately south of King Street;

South Royal Street in the 100 block on the east side, 4 spaces immediately south of King Street;

North Royal Street in the 100 block on the east side, 4 spaces immediately north of King Street;

South Washington Street in the 200 block on the east and west sides, 4 spaces on each side immediately south of Prince Street;

North West Street in the 100 block on the east side, 4 spaces immediately north of King Street;

North Columbus Street in the 100 block on the east side, 5 spaces immediately north of King Street;

King Street in the 1300 block on the north side, 4 spaces immediately east of West Street;

King Street in the 200 block on the south side, 4 spaces immediately east of Fairfax Street.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
