

Ordinance No. 939

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 17-88, Article III, Chapter 17 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, which Section 17-88 relates to SOLICITING AGENTS FOR SALE OF GOODS, ETC., which Article III relates to NON-REGULATORY LICENSES, and which Chapter 17 relates to LICENSES GENERALLY.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 17-88, Article III, Chapter 17 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

SEC. 17-88 SOLICITING AGENTS FOR SALE OF GOODS, ETC.

Persons doing business in the City as soliciting agents or soliciting orders for goods, wares and merchandise, services, business services, repair services, and the like and not otherwise in this chapter taxed shall pay for the privilege an annual license tax of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) and Twenty-nine Cents (\$0.29) per One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) of the gross receipts therefrom in excess of Eight Thousand Six Hundred and Twenty Dollars (\$8,620.00).

Any person engaged solely in the manufacture and sale of his own manufactured goods, wares and merchandise, and who maintains no place of business in the City other than for the solicitation of orders for his manufactured products, and who sells only to licensed jobbers and not to retailers or consumers, and who makes delivery of such sales to jobbers from his manufactured goods, wares and merchandise regularly stored in licensed public warehouses located in the City, shall not be subject to a merchant's license, but shall be licensed and pay a tax under the provisions of this section.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective January 1, 1957.
