

Ordinance No. 940

AN ORDINANCE to amend Article III, Chapter 17 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, by adding a new section thereto numbered Section 17-88.2, which new section 17-88.2 relates to TRADING STAMPS, which Article III relates to NON-REGULATORY LICENSES, and which Chapter 17 relates to LI-CENSES GENERALLY.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Article III, Chapter 17 of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding a new section thereto numbered Section 17-88.2 to read as follows:

SEC. 17-88.2 TRADING STAMPS

Every person engaged in furnishing or supplying to merchants businesses or occupations, trading stamps, checks, coupons, certificates or like things to be used as evidence of purchases made and which entitle the purchaser to gifts or other things of value from the person so furnishing or supplying such trading stamps, checks, coupons, certificates or like things, shall pay for the privilege of doing business in the City an annual license tax of Two Hundred and Twenty-five Dollars (\$225.00) and Twenty-nine Cents (\$.29) per One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) of the gross receipts in excess of Seventy-seven Thousand Five Hundred and Eighty-six Dollars (\$77,586.00) attributable to such operation or business.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective January 1, 1957.
