

Ordinance No. 942

AN ORDINANCE appropriating the sum of \$25,834.14 to the school operating account for the payment of architect fees.

WHEREAS there is available the sum of \$25,834.14 which is unencumbered and unappropriated, and

WHEREAS there are certain architect fees due and owing for work in connection with the public schools of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the sum of \$25,834.14 be and hereby is appropriated to the school operating account to be spent for the payment of architect fees.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
