

# Ordinance No. 975

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE to amend Section 35-15, Article III, Chapter 35 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, by adding thereto an additional item to be designated A-(1.1), which said new item A-(1.1) relates to ANTIQUE SHOP, RETAIL ONLY, which said Article III relates to USE, AREA, ETC., REGULATIONS GENERALLY, and which said Chapter 35 relates to ZONING.

WHEREAS, pursuant to due and timely notice of the time and place of hearing published in a daily paper of general circulation published in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, a public hearing was held in relation to the matters hereinafter set forth, at which public hearing parties in interest and citizens had an opportunity to be heard.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 35-15, Article III, Chapter 35 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding thereto a new item designated item A-(1.1) to read as follows:

A-(1.1) ANTIQUE SHOP, Retail Only

(Limited to retail sales of antique household furniture and bric-a-brac and of copies and reproductions thereof, provided that at least seventy-five percent (75%) of the stock be eighty (80) years old or older, and incidental refinishing and repair thereof, provided that no equipment of over 5 horse power shall be used).

Section 2. That in the opinion of Council an Emergency exists and this ordinance is hereby declared "AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE" for the reason that delay in hearing this amendment could cause the City to lose a substantial business enterprise.

Section 3. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
