

# Ordinance No. 983

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain the last sentence of Section 9-5, Article I, Chapter 9 of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, and the first paragraph, Subsection 2, Section 9 of Ordinance No. 290, known as the Building Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, adopted May 23, 1939 and made effective July 21, 1939, as amended, by Ordinance No. 889, which last sentence of Section 9-5 relates to PLACE OF PAYMENT OF FEES, which Section 9-5 relates to SCHEDULE OF INSPECTION FEES, which Article I relates to ELECTRICITY IN GENERAL, and which Chapter 9 relates to ELECTRICITY; which first paragraph Subsection 2 relates to PLACE OF PAYMENT OF FEES, which Subsection 2 relates to FEES and PERMITS, which Section 9 relates to FEES AND PERMITS, which Ordinance No. 290 is the Building Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, and which Ordinance No. 889 is an AMENDMENT to the FEES AND PERMIT section of the Building Code; and which amendment hereby made relates to CHANGING THE PLACE OF PAYMENT OF FEES AND PERMITS FROM THE CITY TREASURER TO THE CITY COLLECTOR.

## THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the last sentence of Section 9-5, Article I, Chapter 9 of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Fees collected under this section shall be paid to the City Collector.

Section 2. That the first paragraph, Subsection 2, Section 9 of Ordinance No. 290, known as the Building Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, adopted May 23, 1939 and made effective July 21, 1939, as amended by Ordinance No. 889, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

2. Before any permit for the construction of a new building, addition or enlargement is issued, the owner, or the person, firm or corporation doing the work shall pay to the City Collector a fee based on the superficial area of all floors, including basements and roofs as follows:

Section 3. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
