

# Ordinance No. 989

**AN ORDINANCE providing that the sum of Five Dollars (\$5.00) per day of the pay of policemen shall be designated as a STATUTORY SUBSISTENCE ALLOWANCE.**

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Beginning with the fiscal year 1958-59, of the amounts appropriated by the City Council of Alexandria, Virginia, for policemen, the sum of Five Dollars (\$5.00) per day for each work day shall be designated as and shall constitute a statutory subsistence allowance.

Section 2. The purpose of this ordinance is to give policemen employed by the City of Alexandria, Virginia, the tax benefits provided for by Section 120 of the 1954 Internal Revenue Code.

Section 3. Such statutory subsistence allowance shall continue until this ordinance is repealed.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
